

Admission

After receiving a prospectus, parents are asked to make an appointment to be shown around the nursery. This allows us to know who is on the premises at all times. The initial appointment takes around one hour. Parents may need to place their child's name on a waiting list depending on the places available and the age of the child.

Parents will be contacted when a place has become available. Parents and children are then free to come along again for up to eight sessions of approximately two hours, to give them a greater insight into how the nursery is run and to introduce their child into our environment and routine. Many of the questions that parents want answered come to mind during the settling in period.

As each child and their parents have individual needs it may take only a few visits for a child to settle or it may take all eight visits. Whichever it is, all staff will endeavour to make a child's integration into the nursery as smooth as possible.

The time that it takes to introduce a child into our nursery, up to four weeks, is free of charge to parents. We believe that once parents have spent some time with us they can go about their daily business happy with what they have experienced and if we have happy parents we generally have happy children.
